The theoretical and practical aspects of English Language Learners' (ELLs) oral and written language development will be the focus of this course. Teacher candidates will become acquainted with effective tools and teaching ideas to promote ELL's receptive (listening and reading), as well as productive (speaking and writing) language development. The course will address the language and literacy needs of students of diverse age groups, cultural and linguistic backgrounds, and language proficiency, reading, and writing levels.

(3 credits-45 hours)

**\*Based on our experience, most teachers who have recently graduated from college have taken a Literacy course. This course will only be given on-site if there is sufficient need.**

Note: Teachers should take EDU 514 before enrolling in this course. It is also preferable for teachers to have completed EDU 540 and EDU 542.
