Course Description

Technology is not a magic solution for education. It is an opportunity! An opportunity to shake things up, to connect and grow, and to create dynamic learning experiences for our students. Participants meet virtually via Google Classroom to discuss and share lessons and strategies. Additionally Zoom sessions will be available throughout the course as needed for additional support. The date and time for those sessions will be scheduled based on the need and availability of the participants. You will receive an email with information on how to access the Zoom session. The Zoom session will last approximately half hour and will be available to answer any questions you may have about the Course.

- Straightforward and easy-to-use templates for crafting engaging learning opportunities
- Tips and tricks for the implementation of powerful lesson plans

Weekly Assignment Expectations

Participants must complete the following assignments for each week of study:

• **<u>Read</u>**: You will be assigned required reading. You will be expected to read, annotate and reflect on your own practice.

- <u>StopandReflect</u>: You will reflect on the reading by answering **one reflection question** for each of the chapters. Once you have posted your response, read the responses posted by your peers. Then reply thoughtfully to TWO other participants.
- <u>Actions:</u> You will be asked to complete **one action activity** per week. Once you have posted your response, read the responses posted by your peers and respond to ONE other who completed the same activity.
- <u>Shake It Up Assignment</u>: In this section, there will be an assignment that will need to be completed to shake up learning!

You will create a Dynamic Learning Plan! Think about what you have planned so far, and revisit the resources from the previous chapters to think through your ideas.
