The focus of each half day session is as follows:

Afternoon Session II—In-depth Analysis: Teaching the Civic Issues Task

The first administration of the new United States History and Government Regents will occur in the 2021-2022 school year, and NYSED has announced that there will be no Transition exam. Given the instructional disruption experienced in the past two school years, preparing these students for this more rigorous assessment will be challenging. This two part workshop has been designed with these challenges in mind: Strategies for teaching students how to apply the historical reasoning skills (i.e.: Social Studies Practices A-C) to content understandings will be explored and emphasized throughout the two sessions.
